automated system on June 1, 2015*

Now all types of Environmental Resource Permitting (ERPs) and Water Use Permitting (WUP) applications can be submitted online. Additional online features include responses to Requests for Additional Information (RAIs), RAI extension requests, and compliance reports.

Permitting. Environmental Resource Permits (ERP) and Water Use Permitting (WUP) applications can be submitted online including:

- New Projects
- Permit Renewals
- Modifications
- Transfers and Waivers

This includes applications for:

- ERP projects
- Formal Wetland Determinations
- Forestry Authorizations
- Agricultural Pond Applications
- Water Use

Also the following can be submitted online:

- *Responses to Requests for Additional Information (RAI's)*
- *RAI extension requests*
- *Compliance reports*

Information Available Online:

- Any permits issued by the District are available for public view
- Status of in-house applications for ERP and WUP

Create a Secure Account to submit:

- *Permit applications*
- *Compliance data*
- *Permit correspondence*
